Lawrence Thompson, Charles Thompson, John Adams, and Abraham Melluish, who were convicted at the last quarter sessions for this town, were on the 20th alt. delivered on heard the York Hulk in Portsmouth Harbor.

On Saturday last as Mr. Payne, keeper of

the town gaol, was on his way to Portsmouth, with the above convicts, he met with William Groom alias Connor (who escaped from prison on the 18th ult.) in Shoreditch, in consequence of information which had been received, and Mr. P. being in a disguised dress, Groom made a desperate resistance, but he was secured, and taken to Newgate, from whence he was conveyed to Gosnort, to undergo his sentence of transportation.
