











Since the foundation of the College in 1496, music has been at its heart. The College's choirs maintain the Christian heritage of the community through regular services in the Chapel, in addition to special events, broadcasts, recordings, concerts and tours, including an exciting ongoing collaboration with the charity *Songbound* working with children in India.

Unique in Cambridge, the College has two choirs – the Chapel Choir of men and boys, which can trace its roots back several centuries, and the College choir of undergraduate Choral Scholars, founded following the admission of women to the College. The schedule of activities is a busy one and the reputation of the choirs continues to grow.

The Chapel is home to three organs, a two-manual harpsichord and a concert grand piano. The choral foundation includes a Director of Music, two Organ Scholars, up to 25 boy Choristers and up to 30 student Choral Scholars.
